1. Glue the A's together back to back. The same goes for the B's, the C's and the D's. These are the paws of the Hedgehog.

2. Glue F's on E's. These are the eyes.

3. Glue the G's together back to back. Then the H's together. These are the ears of the Hedgehog with one side white and one side black..

4. Take the parts $\mathbf{I}$ and $\mathbf{J}$ and sew them together $x$ with $x$ and $y$ with $y$.

At the back of part K sew some elastic ribbon at the ends for the fingers to go inside when moving the head of the puppet.
Take part $\mathbf{K}$ and sew it to both parts I along $z$.
On parts I sew in the middle of $u$ the $\mathbf{G s}$ and Hs as in 3 above - white facing front.
This is the head of the Hedgehog with white inside mouth.
Position and glue the eyes from 2 above.
Take part $\mathbf{M}$ and sew its $w$ with the back of the white inside mouth also marked $w$.

5. Take parts $L$ and sew together along $v$.

Sew parts $L$ along $u$ with the head of the hedgehog in part 4 above also marked $u$ sewing the ears of the Hedgehog in between the pieces.
Take part $\mathbf{M}$ already sewed to the head, and sew it with part $L$ along sides $u$ of the head and parts $\mathbf{M}$. It is important that there is a hole at the bottom of the puppet for the hand.
The puppet has a head and a body now.
6. Using glue stick paerts $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$ as the lower paws of the hewdgehog. Stick parts $\mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{D}$ as the front paws of the Hedgehog on the upper part of the puppet.
7. Take the 15 black triangles and 5 black trapeziums and sew the sides of the triangles together to form 15 cones and 5 black part cones with the tip of the cone missing. Glue each cone upside down, with the back of the Hedgehog as spikes. Stick the five half cones to the front of the Hedgehog's head to be very visible. To capture more attention to the broken cones, use glitters on the broken parts.


And that is the Hedgenog ready to be used in class.
