







## How to put the Squirrel together

1. Glue the **A**'s together back to back. The same goes for the **B**'s, the **C**'s and the **D**'s. These are the paws of the Squirrel.



3. Glue the **G**'s together back to back. Then the **H**'s together. These are the ears of the Squirrel.



- 4. Take the parts I and sew them together along *x*. At the back of part J sew some elastic ribbon at the ends for the fiongers to go inside when moving the head of the puppet. Take part J and sew it to both parts *I* along *y*. On parts I sew in the middle of *z* the Gs and Hs as mentioned in 3 above. This is the head of the Squirrel with white inside mouth. Position and glue the eyes from 2 above. Position part K (front teeth) at the front of the mouth. You can also use black pipe-cleaners for the moustache. Take part L and sew its w with the back of the white inside mouth also marked *w*. U/
- Take parts M and sew together along v.
  Sew parts M along u with the head of the squirrel in part 4 above marked z and u sewing the ears of the squirrel in between the pieces.
  Take part N and sew it from the middle with part L and the sides with u of parts M. It is important that there is a hole at the bottom of the puppet for the hand.
  The puppet has a head and a body now. All it needs is a bushy tail.
- 6. Using glue stick paerts **A** and **B** as the lower paws of the squirrel. Stick parts **C** and **D** as the front paws of the Squirrel on the upper part of the puppet.
- 7. Take the two parts of the tail and sew them together from all around except on the part marked *t*. Then sew the part marked *t* with the back of the squirrel pulling the two pieces apart as possible so that the tail will remain in position without folding when using the puppet.



And that is the purple Squirrel ready to be used in class.
